



Members Vote December 8

A business meeting will be held following each service on Sunday, December 8, for church members to vote on nominated Trustees to serve on the 2025 Advisory Team.

Trustee Qualifications and Responsibilities

Trustees are lay persons (non-pastors) who serve on the Advisory Team to provide direction and guidance for our church. They must be members in good standing and fulfill the spiritual qualifications of deacons, as described in **1 Timothy 3:8–13**. Those recommended to serve as Trustees must demonstrate spiritual maturity, a willingness to serve, and practical experience in areas such as finance, facility construction, human relations, management, communications, missions or evangelism.

In the same way, deacons must be well respected and have integrity. They must not be heavy drinkers or dishonest with money. They must be committed to the mystery of the faith now revealed and must live with a clear conscience. Before they are appointed as deacons, let them be closely examined. If they pass the test, then let them serve as deacons.

In the same way, their wives must be respected and must not slander others. They must exercise self-control and be faithful in everything they do.

A deacon must be faithful to his wife, and he must manage his children and household well. Those who do well as deacons will be rewarded with respect from others and will have increased confidence in their faith in Christ Jesus.

1 Timothy 3:8–13 (NLT)

Trustees serving Brookwood Church shall have the following powers and duties:

- 1. Provide financial counsel to the Pastoral staff.
- 2. Assist in the interview, selection and employment of pastoral staff.
- Determine compensation of the Senior Pastor, and with the Senior Pastor, of other ordained ministers of the church.
- 4. Serve the church as official representatives of the church in terms of business contracts and other legal matters. Trustees, under the direction of the Advisory Team or, if required, congregational approval, may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the Church and cause to be executed and delivered for the Church's purposes and in the Church's name, promissory notes and other evidence of debt and securities.
- Conduct other duties and activities as requested by the Senior Pastor, pastoral staff or Advisory Team.

The Advisory Team determines the number of Trustees annually, and they are nominated to the church body annually by the Senior Pastor. They are elected by the members at the annual business meeting and may only be removed from completing their 3-year term by a vote of the members.

Trustee responsibilities include:

All trustees serve on the Brookwood Advisory Team, which meets quarterly to:

- · Review and discuss quarterly financial reports.
- · Review and discuss ministry reports and activities.
- Pray for the pastors, ministries and congregation.
- · Hear from and share with pastors what we see God doing in our church.
- · Discuss new business.
- Provide feedback on proposals and plans presented by pastors.

Additional meetings are held as needed to discuss:

- · Annual budget development.
- Pastoral interviews and hiring.
- New trustee interviews.
- · Significant projects.
- · Other matters as appropriate.
