# **Bible Study and Group Discussion**

#### Read John 21:1-19

- 1. Peter and the disciples didn't know exactly what to do after Jesus' death and resurrection, so they went back to fishing. What do you fall back on when you're unsure of God's plans? How do you talk to God about it?
- 2. The disciples weren't successful at catching fish until they followed Jesus' direction. Describe a time you failed on your own and turned to Jesus to follow His direction.
- 3. Jesus invited the disciples into relationship through a meal with Him. How has Jesus invited you into a relationship with Him? Describe that invitation and how you responded.
- 4. Peter had failed Jesus and felt that his denial of Christ would be the end of his calling. Think of a time you felt like you failed God's calling. How did you deal with that situation? How did you include God as you sought restoration?
- 5. Despite Peter's denials, Jesus restored Peter to his mission and purpose. Do you feel that when you've stumbled, Jesus has restored you? Describe a time you were restored by Jesus.
- 6. Once Peter's restoration occurred, he was ready for his mission. How open are you to what God has planned for you? Pray and ask God to reveal His plans to you.

- 7. After hearing Jesus' words, Peter was no longer defined by the words of those around him. Whose words define you? How does Jesus define you? Let His words strengthen and guide you.
- 8. Jesus told Peter how his life would end, dying on a cross. Peter gladly continued his mission despite knowing how he would die. Do you fear consequences for sharing the Good News of Jesus? How do you deal with these fears, and how do you ask God to help you overcome them?
