What if I miss the offering?

For your convenience, we offer online giving at brookwoodchurch.org/give as well as giving centers located in the Concourse.

What should I do if I want someone to pray with me, need encouragement, or wish to make a spiritual decision?

The Care Connections room is a safe place to go and find someone to pray with you, to find encouragement in tough times, or to receive spiritual guidance in life decisions. You will find the Care Connections room in the Concourse, where there is a caring volunteer waiting to greet you.
